John "Jack" Hossack – formerly of Listowel, passed away with his wife Shirley and daughter Evonne by his side, after battling dementia for over two years, at McGarrell Place Long Term Care, London on Wednesday January 19, 2022 at the age of 84. Jack was born in Hamilton on November 6, 1937. He joined the 2nd Canadian Guards on January 6, 1955 and trained in Petawawa. He served until 1965 specializing in demolitions. During that time, he served as a Peacekeeper stationed at Fork York, Soest in Germany. After an honourable discharge he served in the reserves in Brantford from 1967 to 1972. He trained recruits in a student militia program. Following his military career, Jack worked for Hussman's Refrigeration in Brantford for 28 years. After retirement Jack enjoyed travelling with Shirley in their motorhome for over 30 years. His favorite winter destination being Arizona. Jack was a member of the Royal Canadian Legion Branch 259 Listowel. He was a former volunteer driver for the Canadian Cancer Society and VON.

Beloved husband of Shirley (Pipe) Hossack. Loving father of Evonne Hossack (George Murray) and father-in-law of Cindy Hossack. Special grandpa of Katy (Kyle) Smith, Lacey Hossack (Minh Quach), Krystine Hossack and 10 great-grandchildren. Brother-in-law of Robert and Susan Pipe and uncle of Matt, Jason and Brian.
